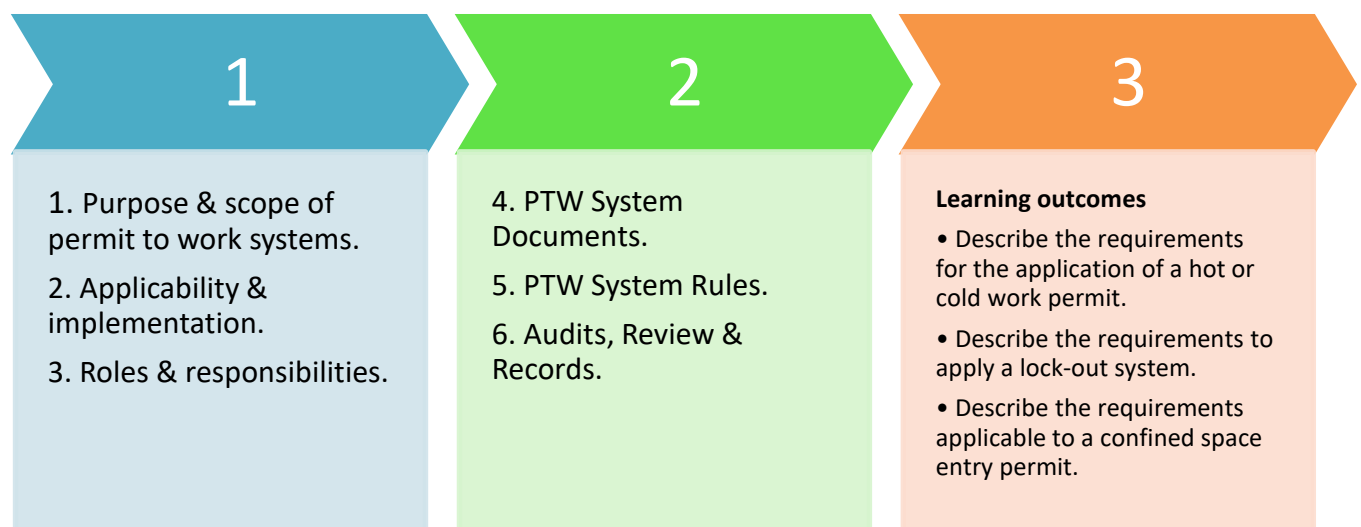
Purpose:

This unit standard will enable the learner to describe the requirements applicable to a permit to work in terms of hot work; cold work; confined space entry and lockout systems in a work area. The permit to work covers permit issuing and permit holding and the separate responsibilities.

Learning Assumed to be in Place:

Communication at Level 3 or equivalent and Mathematical Literacy at Level 3 or equivalent as well as US120330 – Conduct a risk assessment in the workplace. Should earners not have completed HIRA, then the course will be a 2-day course and include HIRA for the first day.
