Purpose:

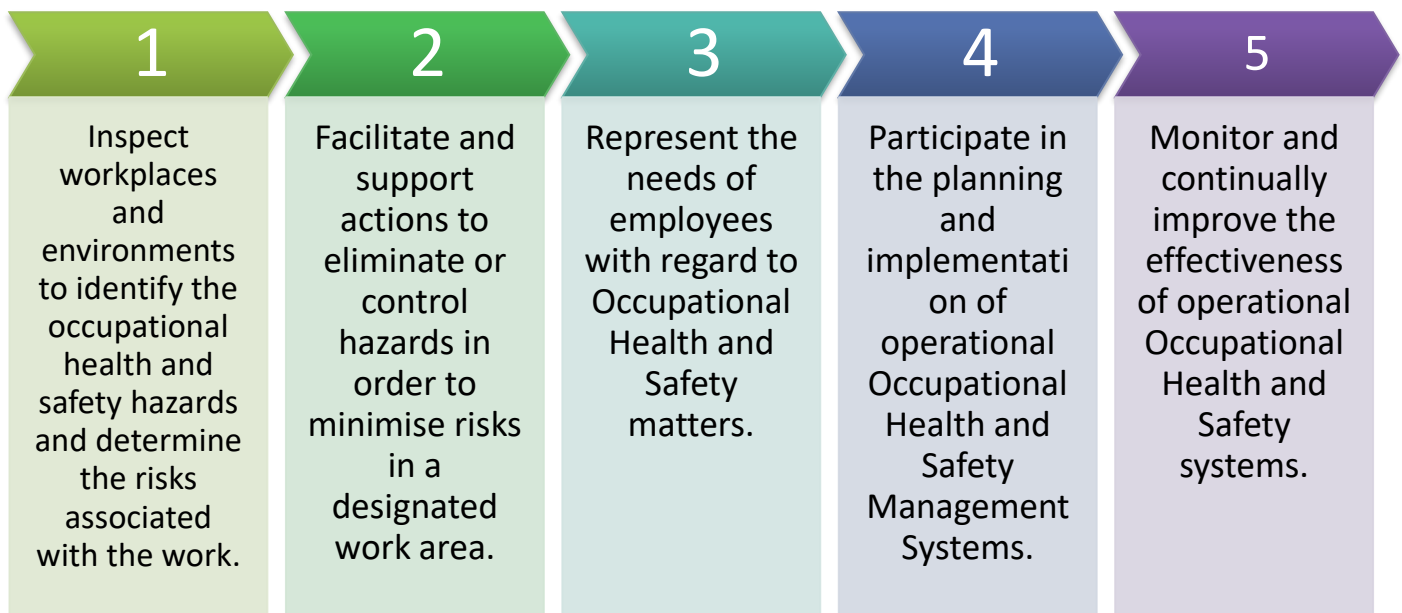
The purpose of this qualification is to prepare a learner to operate as an Occupational Health and Safety Practitioner.

An Occupational Health and Safety Practitioner serves as a facilitator and advisor to employees and management regarding safety and health aspects in the workplace including the monitoring and inspecting of the workplace and the recording and investigation of incidents and accidents. They also implement and maintain Occupational Health and Safety systems in order to ensure a safe and healthy work environment.

Learning assumed to be in place and recognition of prior learning:

A Level 4 qualification with Mathematical Literacy.

Learners credited with this qualification will be capable of:



Method of Delivery: Learning of this module can be Distance learning, Online, RPL, Face to Face.

Course Duration:

Course duration is 1 year, and this course is currently being done on a self-study with an appointed mentor basis. There is a 1 (One) hour monthly MS Teams or Zoom Session built into this Self-study session for 12 months as part of the mentor support and unlimited access to emails and telephonic support.

Workplace learning will be required to be completed by the learner and a workplace mentor will be required for the completion of this course with all the necessary logbook and documentary sign offs. A maximum of 1 (one) year support and mentorship is allocated to this qualification, any further assistance will be charged for over and above the cost of the qualification.

Assessment Fees & Moderations Fees:

Should you not be found competent on any of the learning outcomes. The learner is afforded one reassessment opportunity and one re-moderation opportunity. Thereafter the assessments and moderations will be billed for.

Exams:

1. FSA - Internal Final Integrated Summative Examination is required for the final assessment of this full qualification as per Seta and QCTO Requirements. This is included in the cost and is only advised once the learner is ready for the examination. Examination Pass Rate is 75%.
2. EISA – External integrated Summative Assessment is undertaken by a QCTO Approved External Exam Centre, this cost is determined by the exam center chosen and varies from one exam center to the next, this cost is separate to the qualification costs. The cost is excluded in any training cost and will be for the learners account.

Certificate:

Only Issued by the QCTO once the EISA has been completed and the external moderation is completed. Examination pass requirement (80%) required to pass. This is issued directly by QCTO.

Recognized for Technician Level membership of the Institute of Safety & Health (Tech IOSH), The South Africa Institute of Safety & Health (SAIOSH). Will also earn CPD Points from Saioh.
