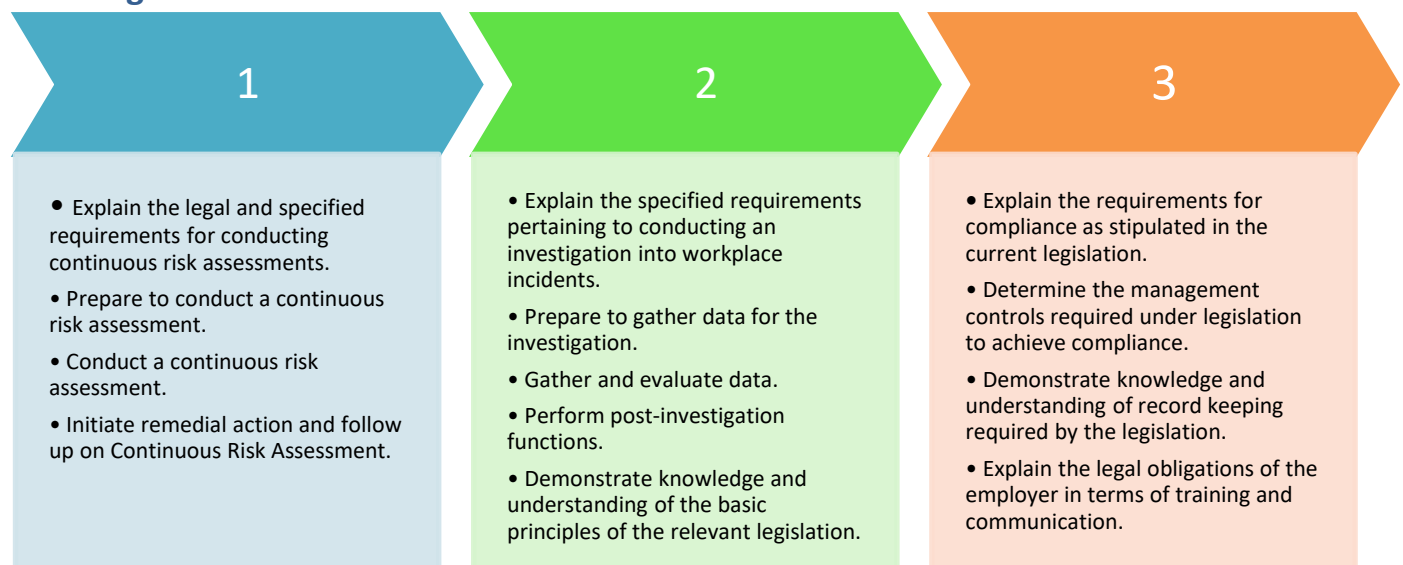
Purpose:

The role of a site supervisor involves the management and supervision of a construction site in accordance with health and safety guidelines. It is the responsibility of the site supervisor to assess hazards, determine risks, conduct regular inspections, and maintain a safety program. Site supervisors should have relevant experience in construction or civil engineering, as well as appropriate health and safety training.

Learning Assumed to be in Place:
